ATTORNEYS: As the seat of Tioga County government and its judicial system, over twenty attorneys are located in Wellsboro to serve your legal needs.

BANKS: Three banks provide customized financial services.

BUILDING CONTRACTORS: A number of building supply companies offer construction services, in addition to the many local independent contractors.

CHURCHES: Religion plays a prominent role in this quiet town. Most denominations are represented.

FIRE & AMBULANCE: Wellsboro boasts an award winning volunteer fire department and an all EMT-trained ambulance service which is supplemented by the local hospital's paramedic team.

HEALTH CARE SERVICES: Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Hospital, located at 32-36 Central Avenue, provides a physician staffed emergency room, radiology, laboratory, cardiopulmonary therapy, and paramedic services 24 hours a day. Health screenings and educational programs are offered at the Hospital and six Health Centers throughout Tioga County. There are three nursing homes in the area as well as three assisted-living residences.

PERSONAL SERVICES: Several licensed beauticians and barbers operate in Wellsboro alone. A wide variety of counseling and social service organizations offer their services in the area of personal needs.

POLICE PROTECTION: A full-time force of well-trained officers serves Wellsboro, in addition to the backup of the Pennsylvania State Police, which has its barracks in nearby Mansfield.

REAL ESTATE: A number of local and national franchise realtor firms are available to help you find the home you want, whether it is one of the many older homes, a new home, or a comfortable apartment that is available. The local newspaper, THE WELLSBORO GAZETTE, and the local shopper, THE WELLSBORO ADVERTISER, will also prove helpful.

RECREATION: Town parks, swimming pools, tennis courts, fitness trails, bowling alleys, an 18-hole golf course, hiking trails and a number of special programs sponsored by the Wellsboro Department of Parks and Recreation are available for everyone to use. Nearby state forests and state hunting lands call to the more adventurous for hunting, fishing, skiing, horseback riding, snowmobiling and hiking.

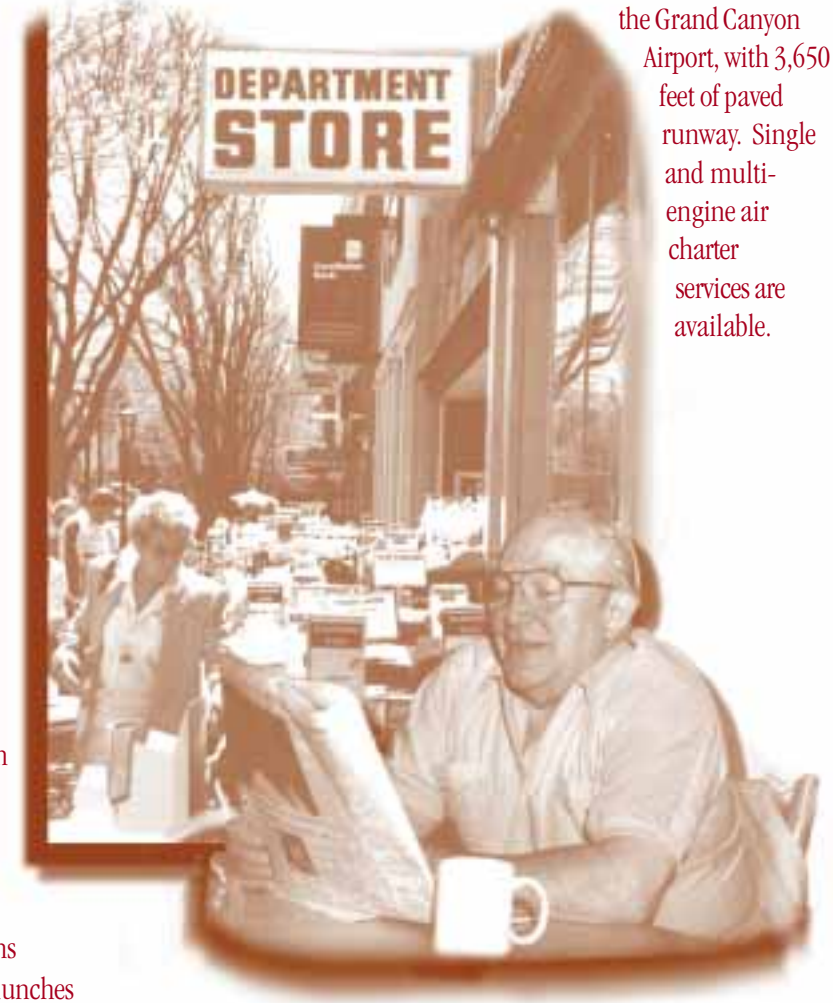
RESTAURANTS: An amazing number of eating establishments are eager to serve your tastes, whether they lean toward pizzas and subs or more gourmet fare. Many are right in Wellsboro, with a large number within easy driving distance.

SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER: An active Senior Citizens group meets in the Community Center for Hospitality House lunches

and planned activities that often include bus trips to outlying locations for shopping or sight seeing.

SHOPPING: Everything you need is available from the friendly Wellsboro area merchants. . . necessities like food, drugs, clothing and luxuries such as sporting goods, jewelry and fine automobiles. It's fun to shop in Wellsboro without the noise and confusion of a large city or crowded mall.

TRANSPORTATION: There are two commercially served airports within 50 miles: to the north – Elmira-Corning N.Y. Regional Airport, to the south – Williamsport Lycoming County Airport. In addition, both airports offer full charter service and car rental at the terminals. Located a few miles from the community is the Grand Canyon Airport, with 3,650 feet of paved runway. Single and multi-engine air charter services are available.

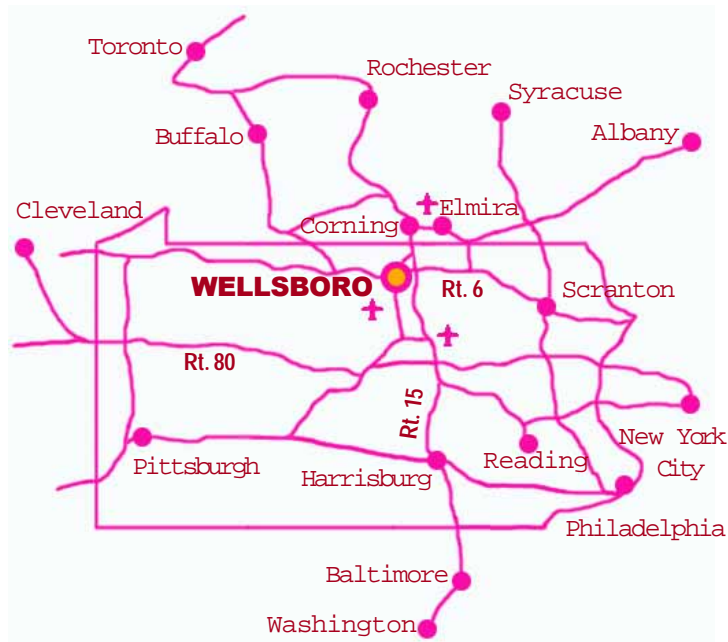
Maybe you prefer politics and will decide to support the local candidate for commissioner, or to run for a position on the borough council or the school board.
